# Maliseet Concerns\*

(from Direct engagement, CEFA reports, NEB sessions)



- Cumulative effects of shipping increases in the Bay of Fundy
- Effects of shipping (collisions, noise) and/or construction & operation of marine facilities (vibrations, noise, sediment) on:
  - Marine mammals (Right, Blue, Fin whales; harbour porpoise – stress, migration)
  - Fish & fish habitat (salmon, groundfish)
  - Aboriginal fisheries
  - Traditional land and resource use
  - Marine wildlife
  - Water quality / clarity
- Effects on air quality from increasing dust and emissions
- Effects on marine environment from oil spills (tankers, marine terminal, storage facility)
- Concern about ability to react to and clean up spills
- Compensation measures after spill or accident in Bay of Fundy
- Participation in emergency response planning
