

## **Weekly Report for Sept. 12-16, 2016**

The team continues to grow in knowledge and fine tuning their practice. This week they were all working on their own test pits, filling out the forms with greater confidence and this week we had a few (Bug, Drew and Laura) flag in transects on their own. They are taking much pride in their work and they are learning a great deal about archaeology and practice.

Approximately 69 test pits were excavated and many more transects lines were established. There were a few quartz pieces that were kept and looked under the microscope but only one piece was kept for further analysis.

The project has been extended for 8-9 days and we will utilize this time to do more work in background research, local mapping, geological maps, flake characteristic check list, follow up after field work is completed, and looking into other fields of study.
